

## Stokes County Aging Planning Committee

### Vacancies

The Stokes County Board of Commissioner is seeking to appoint two members to the Stokes County Aging Planning Committee.

Membership shall consist of county Senior Service providers, a representative from Hospice, Cooperative Extension, and nine other members representing ACTS and senior citizens from different areas of the county who must be over age 60. Terms of membership shall be one year from October until September, except in the case of a vacancy that may be filled at any time for the balance of the term. Members of the committee must be Stokes County residents unless this requirement is waived by the Board of Commissioners.

The committee shall evaluate and advise the Stokes County Board of Commissioners concerning needs, priorities, resources, long-range planning and other issues that affect service to senior citizens in Stokes County, including funding recommendations for the Home and Community Care Block Grant. This committee shall also serve as the countywide aging authority that will continue efforts between senior service entities in the county and ensure that a comprehensive planning process is in place.

Meetings: Regular meetings shall be held quarterly on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the first month of the quarter (January, April, July, October) or as necessary. All members shall be notified of the meeting date and location.
