Position: PHN II (part-time)

Salary: \$19.03/hour (Commensurate with experience)

Location: Danbury, NC with home visits throughout Stokes County

Closing date: Open until filled

Job description: Work requires registered nurse skilled in patient history, documentation, interviewing and counseling patients and families. Must be able to communicate in a professional manner with medical and office personnel, patients, the public, and other community agencies such as DSS, Senior Citizens, etc. Work includes Quality Improvement activities along with home visits requiring considerable nursing knowledge and skills. Requires on call rotation for nursing visits on weekends. Nurse must be able to perform skilled procedures such as: Foley catheter insertion, nasogastric/gastrostomy tube insertions, venipuncture for lab procedures, sterile dressing changes, intravenous fluids, subcutaneous and intramuscular injections and other skilled procedures. Nurse must be able to make independent nursing decisions without close medical supervision.

Minimum

Qualifications: Graduation from accredited school of professional nursing with one of the following: a) BS in Nursing including a public health nursing rotation, b) 12-18 months of professional nursing experience to include at least six months of inservice training or experience in public health nursing or, c) an equivalent of the combination of education and experience. Home health experience preferred.

Special

Conditions: Valid driver's license. Requires use of personal care. Amount of work varies with number and type of patients.
