

Part Time Telecommunicators

Applicant must be 18 years of age or older with a high school diploma or GED and possess a valid driver's license. Must have knowledge of Spreadsheet software and Word Processing software. Typing skills required.

Must be a U.S citizen per North Carolina Division of Criminal Information (DC) Standards

Must be fingerprinted and have a background investigation per DCI Standards

Receives and dispatches emergency and non-emergency calls for law enforcement, fire, rescue, medical, and other emergency services

Questions callers to determine location and seriousness of emergency and response needed. Provides pre-arrival instructions to caller if appropriate.

Coordinates law enforcement (Sheriff's Office, King Police Department), fire, medical, and other emergency requests, relaying instructions to closest and most suitable units available.

Must be able to multi-task and adapt to change without compromising proficiency of customer service

Must be able to operate effectively in unpredictable high stress situations

Must be alert at all times

Must pay close attention to details

Be willing to work flexible hours

Requires the employee to report to duty in all types of natural or manmade situations
There is constant typing, hand/finger usage.

On the job training is provided and State mandated training is required within the first 120 days of employment.
