

# **Announcing Applications for Home Repair in Stokes County**

Piedmont Triad Regional Council has received funding from NCHFA Single Family Rehab Program. These funds are to benefit Stokes County residents to repair homes occupied by low to moderate income elderly or disabled homeowners and homeowners living in a home with lead base paint hazards with children under age 6. Eligible applicants must have total household income below the limit listed below.

**Manufactured or Modular Homes are not eligible.**

All eligible homes built before 1978 will be tested for Lead Paint, Asbestos and Radon.

Typical repairs made with this funding include:

Roof Replacement, Electrical and Plumbing Repair/Replacement, Energy Star HVAC Systems, Replacement Windows, Structural Repairs, Porches, Decks, Doors, Carpet and Vinyl Floor Replacement
