**The Scope of Work Includes** an addition to the existing detention center totaling approximately 15,000 SF. Construction includes precast concrete wall panels, interior CMU partitions, TPO roofing, architectural casework, detention equipment, security electronics, and finishes typically associated with a new detention center. Site-work includes, but is not limited to, the following: storm-water management, demolition, sidewalks, parking lots, grading, and security fencing/gates. Mechanical work includes, but is not limited to, ductwork, plumbing, sprinkler system, smoke control system, and roof top units. Electrical work includes, but is not limited to, panelboards, lighting fixtures, fire alarm, emergency generator, power, technology wiring and infrastructure; and security systems (cameras, intercoms, duress, door controls, and touchscreens).
