**Re: Pesticide Disposal Day**

NC Cooperative Extension and NCDA Pesticide Division want you to know about an upcoming Pesticide Disposal Day scheduled for **Wednesday, November 30, 2011**. Pesticides (herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, etc.) are a part of life for homeowners, farmers, landscapers, golf courses, etc. However, pesticides sometimes become unusable for various reasons. If you have unused pesticides that you no longer plan to use, they can be disposed of at **no cost** at this event.

Again, the date is **Wednesday, November 30, 2011**. You can bring your item(s) from **10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.** to the parking lot of **700 N. Main St. in Danbury** (where the Extension Office is located in the old school building on the hill).

Any pesticide **still in its original container** will be accepted, as long as part of the original label is still attached. **Remember, there is no cost for this service.**
