Stokes County Animal Control

Stokes County has made the decision to modify its current animal control procedures. The modified procedures will remain in effect until further notice. The Stokes County Animal Control Department will perform all animal control functions that are required by North Carolina General Statutes, which require Stokes County to deal with rabid animals, injured animals, dangerous animals, and animal cruelty cases. The Animal Control Department will also enforce and administer the provisions of the local county animal control ordinances **with the exceptions of accepting animals surrendered by their owners any/or other persons and the pickup of stray animals in the county.**
